3. PRICES	President and Parts Coordinator have yet to work through lists. Going to do same when Col Paynter returns from inter-state.

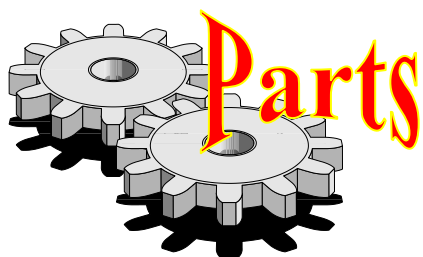
### GENERAL BUSINESS:
